Inventories	Various external Inventory Clerks and In house	The fee we receive will be dependent upon the size of the property, typically we receive a fee equal to 18% of the amount of the invoice from external inventory clerks.
Insurances including Rent & Legal protection; general tenant & landlord insurance products	HomeLet Lettings Hub	Up to 15% of any insurances sold directly by them as a result of the introduction
Conveyancing/Solicitors	Various approved local or national firms	The amounts we receive vary according to the value of the property sale or full scope of the work being undertaken by the Conveyancer/Solicitor. Typically, we receive of between £100 and £200 per introduction.
Mortgages	Various approved local or national firms	The amounts we receive vary according to the value of the mortgage and the brokerage it is with. Typically, we receive of between £100 and £500 per introduction.
